Beginning February 6, 2025, In-N-Out hamburgers, shakes, and fries will be available at our newest location in South Salt Lake, Utah.

As with all locations, fresh ingredients will be supplied to the store from In-N-Out. Hamburger patties are made from 100% American beef and whole chucks are boned and ground by In-N-Out's own butchers. All patties are produced and delivered fresh throughout the week to the stores and are never frozen. French fries are made from fresh, whole potatoes and are hand-diced.

Tessa Standerfer, who has been a veteran of In-N-Out for 22 years, will manage the new restaurant, located at 28 East 2100 S. The restaurant will employ approximately 35 In-N-Out Burger Associates with a starting wage of \$17.50 per hour. There will be one drive-thru lane, indoor seating for 84 guests, and a covered patio with outdoor seating for 19 guests. All In-N-Out Burger locations are open daily from 10:30 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. and until 1:30 a.m. on Friday and Saturday.

In-N-Out has locations throughout California, Nevada, Arizona, Utah, Texas, Oregon, Colorado, and Idaho. In-N-Out was founded by Harry and Esther Snyder and is still owned and operated by the Snyder family. None of the units are franchised.
